Like all of you, I want to see the Police Force that we deserve with more officers on our streets. **Better roads** and a **cleaner** and **saf-er** environment for all of us to live.

Nothing is guaranteed, except this, my promise, if elected, to continue to fight vigorously

for improvements. Firstly in the Shirebrook & Pleasley Ward and secondly across the whole of Derbyshire.

It's been a very difficult time for many of us during the past twelve months or so, and the excellent community spirit we have in the area took the lead in helping those less fortunate.

I was honoured to be able to help out and financially help in the local SNAG box scheme that was based at the Holy Trinity Church last year. The group of volunteers delivered 650 SNAG boxes covering 2,000 meals.
